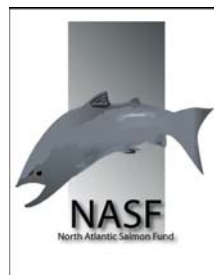

Great year of 2007 for NASF!

We are now preparing for our third NASF reception in Oslo, and we are happy to announce that the auction catalogue is thicker and more tempting than ever! We hope you agree and that it will materialize in terms of the money we will raise on the 25th October.

While 2007 might not have been a salmon season to remember, it clearly documents the need for efforts to reduce netting in order to save as many salmon as possible. Norway is now the only remaining country with a significant net fishery for wild salmon, and reports are being made, documenting that the spawning stocks in many Norwegian rivers consist of far too few salmon.

However, 2007 has been a great year for NASF. The founder and chairman, our good friend, Orri Vigfusson, was this spring awarded the prestigious Goldman Award (www.goldmanprize.org), considered a parallel to the Nobel Prize among environmental prizes! While we salute Orri for the highly deserved prize, we feel that it is also a great recognition of the importance of the work that is done by the people in the Trondheim fjord rivers!

We have also done all necessary preparations to formally establish a Norwegian chapter of NASF, called NASF Norway. It is being registered as a foundation (stiftelse), and will formalize the Norwegian work of NASF. We are about to set up a board, hopefully helping increasing our efforts in Norway, and ease receiving donations and support in other ways.

Finally, NASF has launched a new great book, "A Celebration of Salmon Rivers". It features rivers from all major salmon countries, and the Trondheim fjord rivers are well represented. The book will be displayed and for sale at the auction (see also back side of catalogue). If any of you want to make a bigger order, please contact us beforehand so we can make sure your books will be ready in time.

Our auctions in 2005 and 2006 so far have contributed with more than NOK 1.350.000 to the buy-out. Let us continue this important work with yet another great auction evening.

Thank you for coming to the reception this year! Your participation, the generosity of the donors, and the hard work of the the organizing committee and the host, the Astrup Fearnley Museum for Moderne Kunst, are contributing greatly to the continuing success of NASF and the Trondheim Fjord Buy-Out.

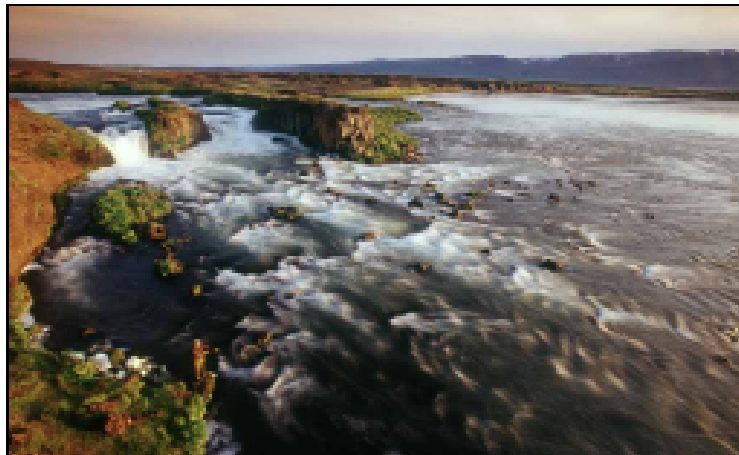
